Mobility Funding for Higher Education and Vocational Education

Erasmus+ Programme

Please refer to your International or Erasmus Office in your institution.

- Eligibility: Students, teachers, and staff in higher education and vocational education.
- Purpose: Supports mobility for study, teaching, and training purposes across Europe.
- Funding: Covers travel and living expenses.

Mobility Funding for SMEs and Industry Partners

Erasmus for Young Entrepreneurs (COSME Programme)

- Eligibility: Young entrepreneurs and small business owners.
- Purpose: Supports mobility for entrepreneurial training and exchange.
- Funding: Provides financial support for stays abroad.
